Recently the Board approved the signing of new leases with the State which secures our access to the land and sea bed needed to progress. This consolidates a range of short and long term leases and licences we previously held over the land we occupy. The next major hurdle is to secure finance for the project. # MUMMS THE WORD..... THE WORST KEPT SECRET IS OUT.....

Bellerive Yacht Club through its training initiative sailBYC are pleased to announce that we have purchased a mumm36 for our training school. This has been made possible through generous support of one of our members and a grant from the State Government. Just waiting for a weather window for Steve Keal and a couple of his friends to deliver the boat. Sadly, the weather so far has been terrible but we still hope to give the club a special Christmas present!

It's really important to us that we encourage participation. You don't have to be top dog in racing as cruising is just as important to BYC's DNA. We want to help people explore the delights of sailing and through training do this safely, so let the office know what you'd like us to do. We're very much open to ideas.

This is the perfect boat for training. 36 foot means its big enough that no one will end up swimming if we hit a gust and its small enough to sail with a small crew. It's a powerful boat if you want it to be, but we're not planning to set up training in a race configuration. Our advantage over other clubs is that in light air we can power up the boat and sail, not float around the river doing nothing. We are fully covered by Australian Sailings "Discover Sailing" initiatives. We are fully endorsed and insured by Australian Sailing to run keelboat courses.

We have a group of instructors who are led by John Mills as chief instructor with Victoria Logan, Simon Demarchelier and myself also available to run courses. We've a few ideas on what training we'd like to offer. The main focus will be on keelboat sailing for adults. As a start we're offering courses on Tuesdays and Thursday evenings from 1730 to 2030. We will be running a women's only course and also offering a group booking / family package. If you can put together five people, we'll offer a 20% discount and we can customise times to suit you. We have some dates which will suit families and those who'd like to get stuck into sailing through Jan and Feb. Minimum age is 13. This could be the perfect team building exercise or if you're looking for something to do with your kids and a couple of mates here the chance to do something different!!

We've placed a few dates on our website to encourage you to give sailing a go. You'll end up with enough skills to do the basic sailing. Doesn't matter if you want to race or cruise. We'll customise our training to suit your needs. So why not give the office a call? We're learning quickly on which courses are popular so please let us know if you have a specific need and we'll give you a call.

Next month more about our new Nav course. Customised for Hobart sailors and the coastal course will extend from this, with passage planning.

# 2020 - ROYAL HOBART REGATTA

For the past 182 years sailing has always been an integral part of the Royal Hobart Regatta program and the Association are determined to continue this tradition.

All keelboat races next year will be held on Sunday 9 February starting at 1.30pm. The spinnaker races are in 2 Divisions and Brierley Marine Chandlery have sponsored both these races providing a prize money pool of \$1000 for each Division. The winner of the Division 1 race will also be presented with the Sir Thomas Lipton Trophy which was made available to the Regatta Association back in 1915.

An exciting addition to our afternoon sailing program is the inclusion of races specifically for non-spinnaker yachts. Co-Op Toyota are sponsoring this event with prize money of \$1000 to be shared equally between 2 Divisions. This is the most popular form of yacht racing on the Derwent and the Association is hoping for a large number of entries.

Entry is free and an entry form and sailing instructions can be found on the Regatta Association website [www.royalhobartregatta.com](http://www.royalhobartregatta.com). If there are any queries contact Geoff Lucas on 0417 352 264.

During this year the Regatta Association has contacted various yachting organisations including Dragons, Mottles, SB20s and Derwent classes in an effort to organise class racing. There has been a lot of interest and plans are still unfolding.

If there are any other class of yachts that would like to compete please contact Geoff Lucas.

As in previous years the Twilight race starts at 6.00pm, again in 2 Divisions. This event is also a non-spinnaker race and similar to last year it has been sponsored by Galapagos Duck. Well-known helmsman Terry Bragg providing \$700 in prize money.

Entry is free and as this race is conducted by the Geilston Bay Boat Club an entry form and sailing instructions can be found either on their website [www.geilstonbayboatclub.com.au](http://www.geilstonbayboatclub.com.au) the Regatta Association website, or by contacting Keith Bolton on 0409 979 490.

It has become a tradition that after the racing, boats assemble off the regatta grounds for the fireworks, which will start at 9.20pm. This provides a great vantage point for viewing and the assembled yachts look spectacular from the foreshore.

Finally, the Regatta Association invites all boat owners and their crew to participate in next year's event and encourage the wider community to come along and watch some great yachting on the River Derwent.


