

A Guide to Keelboat Groups and Classes for 2024 Banjo's Shoreline Crown Series Bellerive Regatta

This document is an overview of the different classes available for the 2024 Banjo's Shoreline Crown Series Bellerive Regatta. It is not part of the Notice of

Race and is only intended as a guide about the differences between the Groups and the races /courses shown are indicative only and may be changed before the Sailing Instructions are published. The 2024 event will also include the **SB20 State Championship**.

Racing Group 1

- For the faster boats.
- Handicapped using PHS, ORCc and IRC. Current certificates required for ORCc and IRC.
- Twilight spinnaker racing on Friday evening.
- Mixture of harbour and windward / leeward courses.
- PHS handicaps adjusted after each race.

Racing Group 2

- Smaller (Combined Clubs Division 2) type yachts.
- Handicapped using PHS, ORCc and IRC (dependent on number of entries). Current ORCc and IRC certificate required.
- Twilight Spinnaker race on Friday evening.
- Mixture of harbour and windward / leeward courses.
- PHS handicaps adjusted after each race.

Performance Cruising (Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker Groups)

- Handicapped using PHS, ORCc and IRC (dependent on entries). Current ORCc and IRC certificate required.
- Twilight Race with spinnakers on Friday evening.
- Harbour courses with spinnakers on Saturday and Sunday.
- Performance Cruising Divisions 1 and 2 is for the faster boats, Division 3 for the smaller boats.
- Performance Cruising Division 4 is for non-spinnaker entrants.
- PHS handicaps adjusted after each race.

Trailable Yachts and Sports Boats

- Handicapped using PHS.
- Spinnaker Twilight Race on Friday evening.
- Emphasis on harbour courses with spinnakers on Saturday and Sunday.
- Classes dependent on number of entries

SB20 Tasmanian Championship and One Design Classes (Saturday / Sunday only)

- Windward / leeward courses.
- Classes dependent on number of entries.
