



NOTICE OF RACE DARK BLUE BYC

Issued by Bellerive Yacht Club as the Organising Authority (OA)

This notice covers the BYC Dark Blue Ice Breaker.

RULES

- Races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021–24.
- The race will be governed by the prescriptions and special regulations of Australian Sailing (AS).
- Appendix T Arbitration of the RRS will apply.

ELIGIBILITY

Entries may be accepted from boats owned by a member/s of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing. Races will be open to monohull keelboats, sports boats and trailable boats. Entries from other boats may be accepted at the absolute discretion of the Race Committee. The acceptance of an entry for a boat shall not create a precedent for entry by any other boat.

Note: Dark Blue BYC is a non – spinnaker event.

SCHEDULE OF RACE

Saturday 13 July 2024 , first warning signal at 17:05 hours using short course/s around lit marks or fixtures.

CREW DECLARATION

- For each race a boat shall submit a Crew Declaration on the form provided on the BYC website and emailed to sailing@byc.org.au or lodged at the Sailing Office before the start.
- The Crew Declaration shall confirm that the boat intends to race and shall include required details of persons on board as follows:
 - i. Name
 - ii. Contact phone number; and
 - iii. Australian Sailing Number in accordance with RRS 46.

INSURANCE

All boats shall have a current Certificate of Insurance for the period of the race or series including Third Party or Public Liability Insurance of not less than \$10,000,000 for any one incident, when racing.

ENTRIES

Entries should be lodged via the Bellerive Yacht Club on the form available on the BYC website from Friday 28 June and emailed to sailing@byc.org.au

Entries close at 12.00 noon on Saturday 13 July 2024

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- Boats shall comply with Australian Sailing (AS) Special Regulations 2021-2024 Part 1; Category 7 (night). Section 3.02.3(a) is mandatory. AS Special Regulations Part 1, Section 5, 5.01.1 (k) (Lifejackets) shall apply.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions for the race will be available from Bellerive Yacht Club website no later than 12 noon on 13 July 2024.

In the event of a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply.

SERIES AND SCORING SYSTEMS

Placings on corrected time based on PHS handicaps will be used to award prizes where applicable. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.
