

Sailing Instructions – Sabre Winter Series 2025

1. Rules

In case of conflict between the NoR and these Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

2. Notices to Competitors

Notices will be posted on the official notice board located in the breezeway outside the sailing office.

3. Changes to Sailing Instructions

Any changes will be posted at least 1 hour before the scheduled warning signal of the race it affects.3.2 Oral instructions may be given on the water as per RRS 90.2(c).

4. Signals Made Ashore

Signals made ashore will be displayed at BYC flagpole. 4.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 60 minutes' in the Race Signal AP.

5. Schedule of Races

Sunday 15 June, Sunday 27 July, Sunday 31 August

Number of Races: Up to 2 Races per day. **Warning Signal for first race: 09:50 hours.** Subsequent race will follow as soon as practicable.

6. The Start

The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Committee Boat and a nearby green flag mark on the port side of the committee boat.

Races shall be started by using the following signals:

<i>Signal</i>	<i>Flag and sound</i>	<i>Minutes before starting signal</i>
Warning	Class flag G 1 sound	3
Preparatory	P, U or Black, 1 sound	2
One-minute	Preparatory flag lowered, sound	1
Starting	Class flag removed, 1 sound	0

7. Courses

The course number will be displayed on the stern of the Committee Boat.

05 Start → 1 → 2 → 3 → 1 → Finish

06 Start → 1 → 4 → 1 → Finish



9. Marks

Mark 1 : Yellow inflatable mark to windward of the starting line.

Mark 2 : Green Inflatable mark as the wing mark

Mark 3 : Black & white chequered inflatable mark at the outer end of the keelboat starting/finishing line.

Mark 4 : Pink flag mark at the outer end of the Sabre class finishing line.

9. The Finish

The finish line will be between a staff displaying a orange flag on the committee boat and a pink flag mark on the starboard side of the committee boat

10. Time Limits

Time limit for the first boat: 60 minutes. Boats finishing more than 20 minutes after the first boat may be scored DNF.

11. Protests and Requests for Redress

Protest time limit: 60 minutes after the race committee returns ashore. Protest forms are available at the BYC Sailing Office. Hearings will be held as soon as possible.

14. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for 1st Place aggregate for the day & performance of the day.

15. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3.

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Series.
